

**NEW HAMPSHIRE QUARTER HORSE ASSOCIATION**  
**SCHEDULE FOR YEAR END AWARDS 2011**  
**-AQHA CIRCUIT-**

**NHQHA will recognize the cumulative efforts of its members participating in AQHA showing by awarding end of the year awards. Awards are based on the class lists of the NHQHA AQHA shows.**

**All members of NHQHA, in state or out of state are eligible. 2011 NHQHA shows will be pointed.**  
**May 15 July 8, 9, 10 August 14 September 11 September 17**

Eligibility for NHQHA/AQHA Circuit Awards:

- A. All exhibitors wishing to be counted for year-end awards must be a NHQHA member in good standing.
- B. The horse must be registered with the American Quarter Horse Association
- C. Points will not be counted until membership and Intent to Show Forms are received by NHQHA and paid in full.
- D. All points will be accrued by the same horse/rider combination.
- E. Exhibitors must accumulate at least (2) points to qualify for Championship awards and at least one (1) point to qualify for a Reserve Championship in any classes shown.
- F. **A complete show record, printed from AQHA.com, must be received by the Points Secretary by November 1<sup>st</sup>.**
- G. Any discrepancies must be addressed, in writing, to the Points Secretary, within thirty days.
- H. If there is a tie for year-end awards, the Points Secretary will take the exhibitor with the highest average per class to break the tie. Example 10 points earned in 5 classes will override 10 points earned in 10 classes.
- I. If an exhibitor wishes to move up into a higher division during the same show season, the lower division points will be forfeited.
- J. All NHQHA shows and classes are guided by the AQHA Rules and Regulations.

In addition to class awards;

High Point Awards will be awarded to the New Hampshire horse that has earned the highest number of total points, with a minimum of 5 points in each of the follow categories:

NHQHA Amateur Horse of the Year  
NHQHA Youth Horse of the Year  
NHQHA Open Horse of the Year  
NHQHA Walk Trot Horse of the Year  
NHQHA Grand Champion Horse

**-ALL BREED SHOW CIRCUIT-**

**NHQHA will recognize the cumulative efforts of its members, riding any breed of horse, participating in NHQHA ALL BREED classes, hosted by the New Hampshire Quarter Horse Association.**

**May 15 July 8, 9, 10 August 14 September 11 September 17**

**All breeds – In State and Out of State Members -Year end awards will be given in 17 Divisions.**

- A. All exhibitors competing toward year-end awards must be NHQHA members in good standing.
- B. Any breed, registered or non-registered horses are welcome. Exhibitors do not have to own the horse.
- C. Points will not be counted until membership & Intent to Show Form is received by NHQHA & paid in full.
- D. All points will be accrued by the same horse/rider combination.
- E. Exhibitors must accumulate at least (2) points to qualify for Championship awards and at least one (1) point to qualify for a Reserve Championship in any classes shown.
- F. All Breed Show Circuit participants points will be maintained by New Hampshire Quarter Horse Association. Your show bill is your receipt. Any discrepancies must be addressed, in writing, to the Points Secretary within thirty (30) days of the show.
- G. If there is a tie for Champion/Reserve year-end awards, the Point Secretary will take the exhibitor with the highest average per class to break the tie. Example 10 points earned in 5 classes will override 10 points earned in 10 classes.
- H. If an exhibitor wishes to move up into a higher division during the same show season, the lower division points will be forfeited.

Eligible classes: lead line

**Walk Trot Events**

2. Walk Trot English ages 18 and under  
Eligible classes- Walk Trot Hunter under Saddle/English Pleasure, Equitation, Trail, Showmanship, Halter
3. Walk Trot Western ages 18 and under  
Eligible classes: Walk Trot Western Pleasure, Horsemanship, Trail, Showmanship, Halter
4. Walk Trot English 19 and over  
Eligible classes: Hunter under Saddle, Equitation/English Pleasure, Trail, Showmanship, Halter
5. Walk Trot Western 19 and over  
Eligible classes: Pleasure, Horsemanship, Trail, Showmanship, Halter
6. Walk Trot Gymkhana 18 and under  
Eligible classes: Walk Trot Barrel Racing, Pole Bending, Stake Race, Egg and Spoon, Command
7. Walk Trot Gymkhana 19 and over  
Eligible classes: Walk Trot Barrel Racing, Pole Bending, Stake Race, Egg and Spoon, Command

**Youth Events 18 and under**

8. English Events 18 and under  
Eligible classes: English Halter, Hunter Under Saddle/English Pleasure, Equitation, Trail and Showmanship
9. Western Events 18 and under  
Eligible classes: Western Halter, Pleasure, Western Riding, Horsemanship, Trail, Showmanship
10. Over Fences 18 and under  
Eligible classes: any fences class; i.e. Hunter Hack, Equitation Over Fences, etc.
11. Gymkhana 18 and under  
Eligible classes: Barrel Racing, Pole Bending, Stake Race, Egg and Spoon, Command
12. Ranch/Stock Events 18 and under  
Eligible classes: Conformation/halter, Pleasure, Trail, Reining, Cutting, Ranch Riding, Working Ranch and Working Cow

**Adult Events 19 and over**

13. English Events 19 and over  
Eligible classes: English Halter, Hunter Under Saddle/English Pleasure, Equitation, Trail and Showmanship
14. Western Events 19 and over  
Eligible classes: Western Halter, Pleasure, Western Riding, Horsemanship, Trail, Showmanship
15. Over Fences 19 and over  
Eligible classes: any fences class; i.e. Hunter Hack, Equitation Over Fences, etc.
16. Gymkhana 19 and over  
Eligible classes: Barrel Racing, Pole Bending, Stake Race, Egg and Spoon, Command
17. Ranch/Stock Events 19 and over  
Eligible classes: Conformation/halter, Pleasure, Trail, Reining, Cutting, Ranch Riding, Working Ranch and Working Cow
