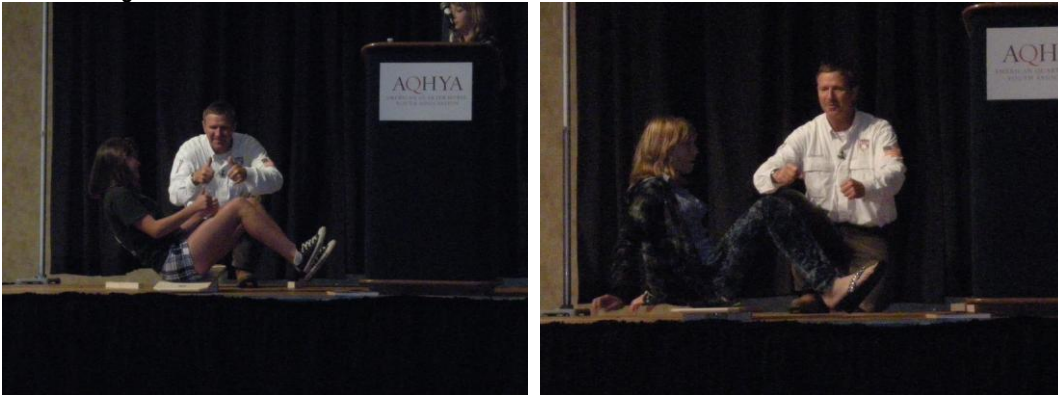
Morghan Morrison, Delegate and NHQHYA Secretary shares her summer experience:

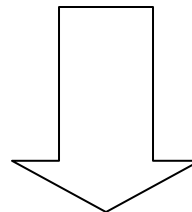
I know I had an amazing time at Y.E.S. and I know that the others did as well. I can't wait to go back next year and run for a regional director.
